Post Award Phase

Always review Terms & Conditions in Assistance Agreement (aka Grant/Award Document)

- Progress Reports & Financial Tracking (CFR 200.329)
 - o Annually, at least, but no more frequent than quarterly.
 - o Quarterly, Semi-Annually, or Annually, and Final Reports:
 - Due 30-days after end of each specified period for **Quarterly** and **Semi-annual**.
 - Due 90—days after end of each specified period for Annual.
 - Due 120-days after end of each specified period for Final Reports.

Drawdowns

- O As required by 2 CFR 200.305(b), recipient must draw funds from ASAP only for the minimum amounts needed for actual and immediate cash requirements to pay employees, contractors, subrecipients or to satisfy other obligations for allowable costs under this assistance agreement. Disbursement within 5 business days of drawdown will comply with this requirement.

QAPPs

o MUST be approved PRIOR to ANY data collection.

QMPs

- o MUST be approved PRIOR to ANY Grant approval with a Financial Action attached:
 - * New Award
 - Supplemental Award
 - ❖ Incremental Award
- o MUST be renewed/reapproved if expiring 30 days or less, prior to award action for ANY grant in Region 6.

Quality Assurance Project Plans (Approval Process)

- All awards will need a signed Quality Assurance Project Plan (QAPP) before any field work can begin.
- We encourage grant applicants to submit QAPPs 60-days in advance of new, or renewal, documents.
- Grantee should send the QAPP, and all referenced SOPs, to the designated EPA project officer (PO).
- EPA's technical staff will review the QAPP and provide comments for the PO to share.(approx. 10 Days)
- The grantee will need to make corrections and send the corrected QAPP to the PO. (approx. 10 Days)
- EPA's technical reviewers will perform additional reviews until document is approvable. (approx. 10 Days)
- The PO will respond, via email, with an official <u>APPROVAL</u> and QTRAK number assigned.
