#### WHY USE ATTAINS?

- Electronic reporting of water quality assessment decisions
- Tracks tribal water quality through time
- Allows tribal data to be reported on a national scale
- Put tribes on the same page as states when it comes to water condition reporting

#### **ATTAINS IS...**

- ATTAINS is NOT a data warehouse
  - Still use WQX!

 ATTAINS does NOT analyze your data for you. This must be performed outside of ATTAINs

 ATTAINS is a place to report water quality assessments and track these assessments over time

### **BENEFITS FOR TRIBES**

- Comprehensive reporting tool in which to submit attainment decisions, assessment methodology, and final report each year
- Big picture analysis of tribal water health
  - •More informed decision making for managers
  - Public transparency
- Prepares tribes for part of the 303(d) TAS application, if interested in applying



#### **BENEFITS FOR EPA**

- Tribal assessment data would be publically available
- Will reduce regional reporting for strategic plan measures
- Aligns tribal reporting with state reporting




#### **REGION 6 ATTAINS UPDATE**

Pilot project in second year


11 Region 6 tribes submitted in FY2017
